Charity concert for disadvantaged children in Hong Kong and Kowloon, live at City Concert Hall, Hong Kong, April 28, 1962. Very good soundboard recording for its vintage.

In Hong Kong Sinatra visited a children's hospital and a youth center. He performed two concerts at the new City Hall organised by George Ho. On the second night, according to the trip diary, "The concert was a total success and the number of people wanting to attend couldn't be accommodated." So when the show ended, Sinatra moved to another part of the hall and gave an impromptu performance. On his final day in Hong Kong, Sinatra did a matinee for the children. When it ended, he presented a cheque for US\$95,000 for charity. - from Nancy Sinatra's book Frank Sinatra: An American Legend
